Learn how to make your own unique and beautiful concrete garden treasures!

Sand casting is a versatile and economical method to produce a variety of garden art. In this workshop participants will create whimsical concrete garden art using a sand cast mask technique. Everyone will make an oversized mushroom shape and adorn the top by embedding shells, pebbles and/or baubles. As a second project everyone will design a basin and choose to embed leaves or other objects into the piece or to create in a manner suitable for mosaic. The basins make perfect bird baths.
